- Facilitate Elections of Future Seated Alumni Council Leadership.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Be able to attend at least one 1 hour meeting each month, sometimes two per month if needed.
- Be able to actively contribute to delegated work and committees outside of meetings.
- Be able to serve as an active founding member through June of 2023.
- Be able to attend quarterly ASMS board meetings if elected to a point leader position.
- Be willing to provide occasional advisory support and mentorship once seated members are elected and active.

NOMINATION PROCESS

ASMS will be sending out a form to alumni and school community members requesting nominations for founding members of the ASMS Alumni Council.

There will be two options for nomination:

1) Self-Nomination -- Submit your own resume and/or LinkedIn URL and statement of interest.

2) Community Member Nomination -- Submit your alumni nominee's resume and/or LinkedIn URL and a statement of support.

Nomination forms will be open from November 2021 through the end of the year.

Deadline: December 31, 2021

The forms will be posted on the ASMS website and LinkedIn page.

SELECTION PROCESS

ASMS will bring together a committee of alumni, faculty, staff, and students to review the nominations and select the 12 - 15 founding members. The committee will meet in January of 2022.

Selection Criteria:

- Balance of Demography
- Balance of Location (in-state and out-of-state)
- Balance of Expertise, Discipline, and/or Field (academic and professional)
- Balance of ASMS Class Year
