Due to the nature of exposure and out of an abundance of caution, school will start remotely next week. The campus will be sanitized and cleaned according to the CDC protocol, and we are working with the Health Department. Earlier this summer, an ASMS task force developed a COVID-19 plan for the 2020-2021 school year. Our Leadership Team is in discussion, and we are continuing to communicate and release plans to our community.
