- 1. Color: White or Silver
- 2. Provide a picture of Vehicle
- 3. Year of Vehicle: 2021 or Newer
- 4. Interior of durable material; leather optional
- 5. 4 Cylinder Engine or higher
- 6. Fuel System: Gasoline not Diesel
- 7. Full Power Option (Brakes, steering, door locks, windows)
- 8. 4 Wheel ABS Brakes Brake Type: 4-Wheel Disc
- 9. Front Wheel Drive
- 10. Air Conditioning
- 11. Minimum Passenger Seating of 6
- 12. Automatic transmission
- 13. One (1) Set of 4 rims with All Weather Tires
- 14. Fuel Tank Capacity, Minimum Approx. (gal): 15.8
- 15. 3<sup>rd</sup> Row Seat
- 16. Minimum of 2 sets of keys, remote type
- 17. One spare key, non-remote type
- 18. Blind Spot Information System: Cross Traffic Alert
- 19. Delivery of Vehicle if more than 25-mile radius of school (ASMS)

II. Proposal Format: all pages should be consecutively numbered, and as follows:

The following format, sequence, and instructions should be followed.

- a. A short one- or two-page summary of the key features of the proposal
- b. The body of the proposal, including pricing.
- c. A detailed description of all costs associated with the requirements listed in this RFP.
- d. Proposals should be submitted in a sealed envelope and contain the person's name, email address, and company name submitting the bid with full address and contact information. Proposals must be signed.

## III. General Requirements

An original proposal must be delivered to the attention of Keidrick Wooten, Alabama School of Mathematics and Science, 1255 Dauphin Street, Mobile, Alabama 36604 no later than **3:00 p.m. on May 2, 2022**. No proposal will be accepted for consideration after this date and time.

## IV. Postponement Of Openings

A bid opening may be postponed by ASMS, even after the time scheduled for bid opening, if the school has reason to believe that the bids of an important segment of bidders have been delayed in the mail, or in the communication system specified for transmission of bids, for causes beyond their control and without their fault or negligence (e.g., flood, fire, accident, weather conditions). At the time of a determination to postpone a bid opening, the new time and date shall be communicated by issuance of an addendum to the prospective bidders who are likely to attend the bid opening. ASMS shall maintain records in the bid file explaining the circumstances of the postponement.
